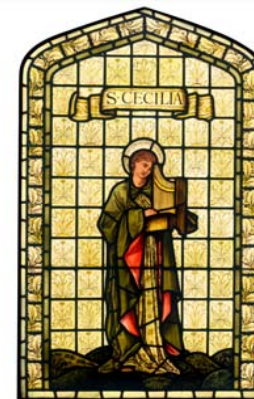
How do I apply?

Where can I get an instrument?

Please note that pianos, keyboards, drumkits and guitars are not available for hire. Pupils learning the piano must have access to a piano or keyboard at home.
